1. When does the campus placement take place during the academic year?

For B.Des. and M.Des. programmes

(1) Graduation project (final semester internship): The campus placement starts tentatively from February.

(2) Full-time employment: The campus placement process starts tentatively from February.

3. What are the typical steps in the placement process?

The typical steps in the placement process would be:

- Communication of interest in the placement programme by registering and sharing company profile, JDs (you may write to placement@nid.edu/industryinterface@nid.edu).
- Corporate Presentations/Webinars/PPTs.
- Finalizing interview date.
- Applications by students.
- Shortlisting of students by employer.
- Interviews.
- Extending offers to selected students.

4. What information is essential in a Corporate Presentation/PPT?

The information that students typically look for in corporate presentations/PPT is:

- Profile of the company.
- Details of the roles and responsibilities.
- Growth path after joining the organization.
- Locations where students are likely to be posted.

5. Who can participate in the placement drive?

Graduation Project:

B.Des. students from the 7th semester and M.Des. students from the 4th semester.

Full time employment:

B.Des. students from the 8th semester and M.Des. students from the 5th semester.

6. What are the various ways in which I can recruit remotely?

In cases, where you are unable to participate in the campus placement processes, it can be conducted through an off-campus mode using video conferencing, Skype, or any online platform.

7. Is there a fee for placement?

Placement Fees is applicable for a campus placement drive.

8. Is the placement guaranteed?

Placement depends on the performance of the student during the selection interview. NID does not guarantee placements for any student.

9. How do I participate in Lateral Placements?
